

Bachelor's thesis "Person with handicap as God's image" is based upon the biblical definition of man and his place in the creation - to be an image of God. It deals with various ways of interpretation of how to cope with this role, and comes to conclusion that a person with handicap, in spite of his/her limited life conditions, is not disadvantaged in this ability. The thesis further focuses on attitudes to the question of healing and finding sense of a handicap in bearing a cross as a way of following Christ. It shows various possibilities of living together of people with and without handicaps, and lays an emphasis on creating of community, where mutual enrichment through different experiences takes place. A person with handicap can be a God's image in a specific way, and therefore has a unique importance for a community.
