

This bachelor's thesis explores, and ascertains, the view of Vietnamese adolescents regarding parenting styles in the Czech Republic. The theoretical part describes parenting styles in an American-European context, Confucianism in Vietnamese society, Vietnamese families in Czech Republic and different factors that could influence parenting styles and a Vietnamese family's life in the Czech Republic, such as: integration of Vietnamese, identity of the second generation of Vietnamese migrants, Confucian concept of family ideology and upbringing, etc. The practical part analyses a young, Vietnamese girl reflection about the upbringing of her parents.
