

This B.A. thesis is describing the activities of Jewish societies-organizations in Prague in the period from the establishment of Czechoslovakia in 1918, to September 1938 when the Munich Agreement was concluded and the subsequent dissolution of the so-called first Czechoslovak Republic in October 1938. The significant part of the thesis is the description of division of Jewish societies in the capital city Prague. The division could be based either on language or ideology. In the last part this thesis is dealing with a number of societies, the legislation and ambience that affected the Jewish societies during the 1920s and 1930s.
