

Abstract: Currently one of the key political issues is the search for effective solutions to overcome the migration crisis. Rapid growth of social and political tension, which leads to the intensification of activity of right-wing parties and movements around the world, can be observed. During the political struggle, politicians are able to form certain stereotypes, beliefs and values of the audience with the help of special linguistic means.
