## **Summary**

Thetheoretical part give san overview of oldage concept, itsperiodization and charakteristics of concret paging periods, changes in oldage and the process of adaptation to oldage. The observation focused theperceptionofthe mening oflife by seniorsthemselves, process on thefactorsthataffectit, thespecificsoflife in a homefortheelderly, lifechanges and the influence oftheattitude to death on the experience of life.
