Abstract

My thesis focuses on librarian profession. The theoretical part present the diference between todays librarian and librarian from the last century. It describes the profession from the point of view of public, including stereotypes; it also mentions librarian education and competencies. One part is focused on librarianship abroad. The research part was carried out using questionnaire that was aimed at how young people in their final year of high school view librarian as a profession, whether they agree with the stereotypes or not.
