

Abstract

This Bachelor's thesis „The moral and spiritual profile of a christian in the work called Paidagogos of Clement of Alexandria“ deals with the great character of Christianity in the second century – Clement of Alexandria, his life and work in the context of his ideas collected in Paidagogos, which seeks answer the question of what it is to be a Christian in the practical moral and spiritual life.
