Abstract

The presented diploma theses is focused on historical linguistics analysis of 32 archival documents written in German language which are related to the Fugger family and their activities in the Czech Lands in 1529–1691. The historical oriented introduction presents the situation in the Czech Lands in the 16th and 17th centuries, Fugger family and development of offices. The second part is focused on linguistics and describes the advancement of office languages and historical context. The textological analysis oriented on macrostructure of the text and selected aspects of the language leads to the determination of text types, classes, kinds, and functions. The performed study contributes to the investigation of German offices language in the given time period and simultaneously opens the possibility of linguistic and historical research.
