

Reflection

The diploma thesis deals with the topic of teaching during the coronavirus crisis. The coronavirus brought not only a disease, but also a pandemic which had global consequences for the population. People were affected by social, economic, psychological and physical consequences. This thesis deals with the impact of the pandemic on education and the form of teaching during this period. The teaching profession that was interrupted and limited at one point. Teachers were faced with a new situations brought by the closure of schools. A considerable amount of space is devoted to teaching itself, especially distance learning and it mentions its positives and negatives. A short cross-section of the history of teaching and its interruption is also interesting. The thesis is divided into two parts: theoretical and practical.

The theoretical part is devoted to important concepts related to the coronavirus disease, the occurrence and development of the pandemic itself. It also deals with the beginning of the coronavirus crisis in the Czech Republic and what effects received Czech education. Then the form of teaching before the pandemic is explained. It presents a form of distance education which became the only solution in this time. A short history of education in the Czech Republic is also mentioned, as well as a chapter where are the reasons for closing schools or interrupting education in the past.

The practical part is devoted to empirical investigation where are described methods of data collection, which was a semi-structured interview. Selection of respondents and data analysis itself. The research questions were directed primarily at the teaching profession during the pandemic and the form of teaching. An important aspect of this part of this thesis is also the interview with the director of the school where the research took place. Last but not least is also included here my personal experience from the role of teacher during the pandemic but also in the role of an university student in the named period.
