

Abstract

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The main goal of the bachelor's thesis is to recognize the attitude of the pregnant woman to precancerous lesions and cervical cancer and its prevention.

The theoretical part of the bachelor's thesis is largely devoted to the concept of prevention, its division. It analyzes individual types of prevention, focusing on the prevention of HPV in pregnancy. It also deals with precancers and cervical cancer during pregnancy and their solutions.

The empirical part consists of quantitative research. The questionnaire focuses on the attitude and view of pregnant women on the prevention of precancers and cervical cancer, especially on primary prevention - vaccination, the risk of HPV infection during pregnancy and knowledge of individual concepts related to the issue. The examined sample consists of pregnant women aged 18 and over. 55 female respondents who met the criteria of age (18 and over) and current pregnancy took part in the research.
