

This diploma thesis deals with the topic of multidisciplinary cooperation in nursing homes. At the beginning of the work, a chapter on nursing service is prepared, where everything related to it is described. From the nursing service, the text of the thesis moves to the group of seniors, old age and aging, where all important concepts are defined. The next chapter deals with the quality standards of social services, and the following, the fourth, shows what other social services can be used by people belonging to the PS target group. In the fifth chapter, the thesis deals with multidisciplinary cooperation, the composition of the multidisciplinary team and the experts who can be part of the team. There is also a code of ethics. Chapter six describes two facilities, specifically two nursing homes, where the research was conducted. The chapter is supplemented by price lists in Annexes 3 and 4. The penultimate chapter, entitled Long-term care, is also important for this work, as this topic is again closely related to nursing services and, above all, multidisciplinary teams and cooperation between individual members. The last eighth chapter, or the practical part of the thesis, already points to the research itself, which was prepared for this thesis. This part is therefore made up of research that was carried out in two ways and was thus divided into two parts. The first part took place at the Ladara facility, where I collected data by interviewing respondents. The second part in CSOP Prague 15 was originally supposed to take place in the same way as the first part, unfortunately the whole process was complicated by employee illnesses and so the second part of the research was carried out using the questionnaire method. Three respondents from each facility took part in the research, i.e. 6 respondents in total. At the beginning of the practical part, there is a description of how the entire research was carried out, a description of both environments in which the research was carried out was also created. In the data analysis, the comparison and contrast method was used as an investigation method. The data analysis is followed by a description of the respondents' statements, which contains a short summary, and at the same time comparative tables are presented to it, which serve to better clarify the research and the answers. For further investigation, I would suggest converting the qualitative research to quantitative research and it would be conducted with more clients of both facilities.
