Evaluation of the doctoral student: Olena Koshyk, MD

Olena Koshyk, MD completed her master's degree in general medicine at the Faculty of Medicine of the State Medical University, Donetsk, Ukraine in 2002. In 2003, she finished the residency program in Pathology, in Donetsk, Ukraine, and acquired specialization as a pathologist. Since 2003 she worked as a surgical pathologist at the Donetsk Regional Cancer Centre, Department of Pathology, Donetsk, Ukraine. From 2014 till now, Olena Koshyk, MD was employed by the Medical Laboratory CSD (formerly CSD Health Care), Kyiv, Ukraine as the head of the department of pathology position.

Olena Koshyk, MD entered the doctoral study program in the field of "Pathology", on October 1st, 2019, and she has completed her studies under my supervision.

Olena Koshyk, MD completed all prescribed exams and courses according to the study plan. **Olena Koshyk, MD** is very hardworking and goal-oriented, her studies end in the standard time of 4 years. She is active in lecturing, not only within the workplace but has repeatedly spoken at other conferences, including international symposiums.

Olena Koshyk, MD is the author or co-author of 6 original scientific works, in 1 works she is the first author. All works have an impact factor (IF total IF = 26.409). Her publishing activity significantly exceeds the requirements placed on a candidate for a doctoral study program.

The topic of the dissertation of **Olena Koshyk, MD** is "Clinicopathological, morphological, immunohistochemical, and molecular biological characteristics of rare salivary gland tumors". The dissertation is carefully written, both in terms of the form and content, it is entirely satisfactory.

I unequivocally recommend the dissertation for defense, and after its successful defense, I suggest Olena Koshyk, MD to be awarded a PhD title.
