

Abstract

The bachelor thesis deals with the exile work of Yevgeny Nikolayevich Chirikov, an important Russian writer, playwright and publicist of the late 19th and early 20th century and a migrant in interwar Czechoslovakia.

In the first part we will focus on Chirikov's literary activity in Russia, his publications in magazines and the reasons that forced him to leave Russia.

The second part focuses on his life in Czechoslovakia, where his works reflect on serious themes such as revolution, civil war and Bolshevism. His work has been translated into many other languages, including Czech. The thesis aims to create a comprehensive overview of the writer's life and work in exile.
