SUMMARY IN ENGLISH

The aim of this bachelor's thesis is to focus on selected Italian light verbs in combination with a deverbal (or a denominal) noun with the suffix -ata and to compare them with their Czech equivalents. The first part will be focused on the description and definition of basic concepts such as light verb, deverbal, and denominal nouns with the suffix -ata. The second part of the thesis will deal with the descriptions of selected light verbs: fare, dare, and prendere, as well as their combination with nouns. In the last part, on the basis of data from the parallel corpus InterCorp, it will concentrate on the Czech equivalents of the aforementioned selected light verbs with nouns with the suffix -ata.
