## ABSTRACT

The bachelor's thesis contributes to the research in the field of current state of phonetics and phonology in the dialect of the fringe dialectal region of Náchod, which belongs to the North-Eastern Czech dialectal area. The research focuses on a representative of the oldest generation of speakers. The aim of the thesis is to explore the current state of phonetics and phonology as attested by an idiolect. The thesis is divided into two main parts, namely the theoretical and practical parts. In the former part, the thesis gives a summary of previous linguistic research in the North-Eastern Czech dialect group, with an emphasis put on the peripheral Náchod region. The latter part focuses on the research proper, specifically on phonetical and phonological analysis of transcribed recordings obtained by semi-structured interviews with one informant aged 84. In the concluding section of the thesis, our findings are compared with the previous research.
