	profitable deals with his Chinese counterparts. The thesis uses this as a starting point to analyze Trump's							
	discursive portrayal in Hong Kong media of different political leanings. The conclusion that these political ties correlated with differences in writing about Trump is unsurprising but well-supported.

On one hand, the text and the thesis structures sometimes do not match, and some potentially helpful parts are missing which makes the thesis less convincing. On the other hand, the actual analysis is well executed and the results and their discussion is relevant.
