Abstract

The topic of the thesis is Analysis of higher education about the non-profit sector in the Czech Republic, in which I deal with the analysis of educational programs and courses focused on non-state non-profit organizations. In the theoretical part, I first focus on the development of the non-profit sector, or non-governmental non-profit organizations in the United States of America and the Czech Republic. Next, I explain the concept of professionalization and commercialization, which relate non-profit to changes in non-state organizations and have an impact on the demand for specific education. In the last chapter of the theoretical part describing a research report analyzing managerial education of non-state non-profit organizations at universities in the Czech Republic. I then compare my own research with this report and compare the obtained data from different points of view (e.g. level and form of education, regional location, etc.). I present the current state of course offerings and programs focused on the non-profit sector in the empirical part of the thesis, where I also focus on sectoral education, which is specific to the area of the non-profit sector. The aim of the diploma thesis is to find out the current state of course and program offers and to confirm or reverse a possible shift in the field of education about the non-state non-profit sector.
