## Evaluation

Major criteria:

This thesis examines the role of misogyny as an important motivating factor of right-wing extremism. The thesis is introduced by a robust literature review that appropriately situates the issue under investigation within the disciplinary context of P/CVE, including valid gender perspectives. The analytical framework is built on three factors that are consistently operationalized, allowing the author to thematically invest primary and secondary sources.

The research design is exemplary. The paper is consistent, and the line of argument is evident in the text. The empirical conclusions are convincing and interesting. It is unfortunate that the author does not relate her results more clearly to existing knowledge. It would be interesting to see how her results are counterintuitive in relation to the existing literature..
