Summary:

This work describes the education of girls in the Czech lands during the 19th century and the first half of the 20th century with emphasis on the discussion of secondary education of schools for girls operated by church related institutions. Within this work the history of the Congregation of the School Sisters of St. Francis and its educational activities are described. One of its institutions, the Training School for Girls in Chrudim, including its history, teachers and educational methods is described in detail.
