ABSTRACT

In this thesis, we have dealt with an original example of Early 20th Century Neo-Gothic sacral architecture in a mountinous setting

of the High Tatras in Slovakia - St. Anne Church in Tatranská Javorina. We have analyzed the typologiy of the building, as well as

written sources on inventory? of the church, as well as on later maintenance works. We made a record of a local ecclesiastical life,

influenced by translocations between two parishes. The special impact of this thesis is the definition both of the designer (Karl

Klimm) and the model of the examined building.

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
