

## English summary

In the Teschen region of Silesia lies the town of Český Těšín. The large number of sacral buildings there testifies to the religious nature of the town. Their presence leads us to ask the question why the inhabitants of the town built four large churches and established other places of prayer within a period of only a few years.

The aim of my work is to describe the organisation and formation of the individual parishes and congregations of all the Christian denominations and the Jewish community in Český Těšín in the period from 1918 to 1930, and to ascertain what led up to them being established, and when and for what reasons the churches of the different denominations were built.
