Bachelor thesis entitled *The chosen Romani political activities in the Czech Republic since 1993* focuses on the involvement of Roma and Non - Roma political activists - leaders in the major events in the nineties. In the introduction, it incorporates the topic into historical context, where is mentioned for example the existence of Roma dissent. It also includes the political context of the majority based on the political science literature. Based on archival material, literature and interviews with Roma politicians - the activists, Romani movements and parties at that time are described. The central part of the work examines how Roma activists - politicians opposed to the various events in the nineties. For each year are selected up to three events based on reading the Roma press and interviews with Roma activists. These events include: Law on Citizenship, Migration, New concept of Roma integration.
