

Abstract

This bachelor thesis deals with the use of correlates of German and Czech verbs. First the theoretical part sums up the knowledge about correlates in form of pronouns *es*, *das*, *dessen*, *dem* and in form of pronominal adverbs, afterwards the Czech equivalents of correlates called correlativa are described. In both cases attention is paid to forms, functions, obligatoriness, optionality and position of correlates and correlativa. The practical part focuses on the analysis of the concrete language examples from the parallel corpus *InterCorp* and on the basis of these examples it explores and concludes in which way the use of correlates in German is coincident with the use of correlativa in Czech.
