The Czech Art Nouveau sculpture is represented by severalleading tigures, most of them graduates from the Specialist School of Figural Sculpture of .Josef Václav Myslbek, among wmch Stanislav Sucharda ranks. He is well known mainly thanks torus monument of the Czech historian František Palacký in Prague and to a large nuruber of plaques aM medals. Ris works from the sphere of architectural sculpture wruch are decorating many newly-constructed prague buildings remain unnoticed.

He specialized in the decorative sculpture since he was student and all his works were immediately favourably received. He collaborated with many renowned architects during Ws life. The most intensive and inspiring was ms partnership wiw the architect Jan Kotěra in hlseatly Art Nouveau period.

This study dea1s with the questions concemling decorative sculpture and Hs role in the period building practice, as wen as the influence of The Sch001 of Applied Aru and its teachers on architects and sculptotSand the approa,ch of public anderitique including the architects and sculptors themselves to this theme. The mam task is to make up a listot Sucharda's decorative sculptures created for new public buíldíngs, private villas, bridges, fountaines, temporary exhibition pavilions and others.

Stanislav Sucharda (1866-1916) wasbornin Nová Paka in a family, whe1'e theeraft of sculpture had a long tradition. He was the son of the sculptor and carver Antonín Sucharda, whose workshop concentrated on restoration and gílding or church statues and other pieces of churchequipment~ Ris talent was Inherited by almost al1 his ehildren, in addítion to Stanislav it was his s1ste1' Anna and brother Vojta.
