Abstract (in English):

One of the largest directions of Russian language evolution goes into nouns generated by suffixes.

The most active dictionary expanding with suffix-based forms of words happened in the beginning of XXI.

Based on on research and analisys of linguistic literature the thesis attempts to describe main features of suffics-based noun generation in Russian language in the beginning of XXI.

Thesis operates with three groups of nouns in modern Russian language:

- suffix-based nouns that stand for abstractions
- suffix-based nouns that stand for objects
- suffix-based nouns that stand for animacy
